



February Minnesota Survey Crosstabs

Methodology

This survey of 800 Minnesota adults was designed by Wave Polling and Research and fielded online from February 6 to February 10, 2026 via Verasight, a mixed-mode survey provider. The margin of sampling error is ± 3.5 percentage points. The sample was weighted to match state-level population benchmarks on age, race/ethnicity, sex, income, education, and metropolitan status, as well as to population benchmarks of the 2024 presidential vote and party affiliation via the Pew Research Center’s NPORS survey. Several question batteries used split-sample randomization of scale direction; responses were recoded to a consistent direction before analysis. Cells with fewer than 50 unweighted respondents are suppressed (*).

Percentages are column percentages within each banner category. Some banner categories exclude respondents with missing data on the grouping variable; column totals may therefore be smaller than the overall sample size. The Twin Cities column uses MSA-specific weights for the 491 respondents in the Minneapolis–Saint Paul metropolitan area.

- **Twin Cities** — Minneapolis–Saint Paul metro respondents, weighted with MSA-specific weights.
- **Party ID** — Dem, Rep, Ind (leaned: independents who lean toward a party are grouped with that party).
- **Race/Ethnicity** — White, Black, Latino, Other. Hispanic ethnicity supersedes race.
- **Age** — 18–29, 30–44, 45–64, 65+.
- **Gender** — Male, Female.
- **2024 Vote** — Trump, Harris, DNV/Other (did not vote or voted for someone else).
- **Religion (Pew)** — White Evangelical (White non-Hispanic born-again Protestant), Black Evangelical (Black born-again Protestant), Mainline (other Protestant, Mormon, Orthodox), Catholic, Other (non-Christian faiths), None (atheist, agnostic, nothing in particular).
- **Parents born outside US?** — Based on Q14: “Were either of your parents born outside the United States?” Both = both parents foreign-born, One = one parent foreign-born, Neither = both parents born in the U.S., Not sure = not sure or prefer not to answer.
